


# Approaches to the synchrony and diachrony of back fricatives in three dialects of Spanish

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## Introduction

This ongoing investigation examines the production of back fricatives in Spanish.

From a gestural perspective, the aim is to understand the linguistic changes of these sounds.

Synchronously we describe three dialect patterns for a /x/ phoneme realization.

## Synchronic perspective

### Material and Methods

#### Informants

We recorded:

- One subject from Madrid
- Two female informants, both from Paraguay;
- Nine informants from Caribbean areas:
  - four Colombians, three women and one man,
  - one Venezuelan male;
  - one female from El Salvador;
  - one male informant from Costa Rica;
  - and one Cuban male.

All informants have a high educational level with age varying from 25 to 35 years.

#### Target sound

- The phone varies according to its occurrence between [a]\_[a],[i]\_[i] or [u]\_[u].
- In order to deal with the difficulty of finding infrequent vowel pairs, we used a search tool called CORDE (*Corpus Diacrónico del Español*).
- The corpus was collected at Phonetic Laboratory of the Consejo Superior de Investigación Científica (CSIC), located in Madrid, Spain.

- [-s] ~ [-h]





Figure 6 Gestural scores for the word *pasta* in Western Andalusian (left) and Porteño and Puerto Rican Spanish (right).




[a]\_[a]: caribbean, paraguayan and Madrid's varieties --- *paja* 'straw'



[i]\_[i]: caribbean, paraguayan and Madrid's varieties --- *vigilaba* 'he watched'




[u]\_[u]: caribbean, paraguayan and Madrid's varieties --- *lujuria* 'luxury'



## Diachronic perspective

- f- > h > Ø

- 1) [f] ~ [ɸ] > [h];
- 2) [f] ~ [hɸ]/[ɸh] or [f] ~ [ɸ] > [h];
- 3) [f] ~ [h] > [h];
- 4) [f] > [h], induced for a vasque interference;
- 5) Variation according to vocalic context
